Walter L. "Moon" McCloskey Sr., 81, longtime Broomall resident, died May 1 at Bryn Mawr Hospital. Mr. McCloskey was born in East Lansdowne to the late James and Adeline McCloskey. Mr. McCloskey was a World War II Army veteran, and had worked for SEPTA's Red-Arrow Division as a trolley driver before retiring in 1984.
